Jews & Greeks were at odds with each other;


There disputes over doctrines;

Low to High Concern for Other




7 Causes of Conflict


- 1. <u>Satan's Influence</u>. The Bible describes Satan as a deceiver and father of lies, who disguises himself as an angel of light and goes around the earth tempting individuals and looking for people to devour.
- 2. <u>Personal Attributes, Attitudes, and Action</u>. Interpersonal tension often begins and escalates with people whose personality traits, attitudes, perceptions, feelings, mannerisms, and behavior create conflict and distrust.

- 3. <u>Group Attitudes and Belief</u>. These group beliefs impact individuals within the group, influencing how they think and act toward people who are in a different group. The group beliefs can be dangerous idea that propel groups to conflict.
- 4. <u>Conflict Pattern</u>. Conflict involves a struggle that occurs when two or more people have goals that appear to be incompatible, or when they want something that is scarce.

- 5. <u>Lack of Commitment</u>. In this postmodernism, loyalty to friends, family, church, business associates, and country is discarded when it gets in the way of self-fulfillment or personal advancement.
- 6. <u>Communication Failure</u>. The essence of good interpersonal relations is good communication. Interpersonal tensions often arises when communication is inefficient or in danger of breaking down.

- 7. Social Irritants. Event or conditions in society can prevent or hinder good interpersonal relations, such as:
- Crowded and uncomfortable urban areas;
- Prolonged heat waves;
- Squabbling in the house;
- Economic strife (Can you name others?).
