During the second week of April 2020, President Lattimore received a call from Mrs. Kyna Grubb, the Executive Director of Rowan

Program Services Committee. Mrs. Grubb had a simple request. She wondered if it might be possible for the Seminary to consider housing a small group of families that had become homeless due to job loss resulting from COVID-19. Dr. Lattimore indicated that the Seminary had, several weeks prior, pivoted to 100% online coursework. Thus, regular commuter students were now engaged in virtual theological studies and some rooms were not occupied. Following two conversations, a covenant between HTS and RHM for temporary emergency housing was reached. During new seminary student orientation, President Lattimore
